# Offer from the Serviepoint: Registration with the City

The Servicepoint has a special offer for you. Registering with the City of Heilbronn will be a mandatory appointment for you with the City's administration (mandatory for all students: EU and non-EU). You can do it on your own, but you can also do it within an appointment which is exclusively reserved for you as a TUM student in collaboration with the Citizens' Registration Office, and therefore it will take place much earlier than if you would do it on your own. So we can warmly recommend to take advantage of the offer.

If you would like to do this, please make an appointment with Servicepoint (<u>servicepoint@chn.tum.de</u>) for ONE of the below-stated dates (first come, first serve!):

- Tuesday, 15 October from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m.
- Wednesday, 16 October, from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m.
- Wednesday, 22 October, from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m.
- Tuesday, 12 November, from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m.

Before visiting the Immigration Office/City Hall, ensure you have prepared all required documents as far as possible:

- Passport/ID card
- Housing provider confirmation
- student ID

Please note: The Servicepoint can influence neither the processing time nor the decisions of the authorities. The general deadline for registering (within 15 days after your move to Heilbronn) does not apply if you take advantage of this offer.



## Offer from the Serviepoint: Apply for your residence permit

All non-EU students must make a second appointment with the immigration office to obtain their "residence permit".

These appointments are individual, and the schedule will be given to you at the end of the "registration with the city" appointment.

You can do it on your own, but you can also do it within an appointment which is exclusively reserved for you as a TUM student in collaboration with the Aliens Department, and therefore it will take place much earlier than if you would do it on your own. So, again, we can warmly recommend to take advantage of these two offers.

Please note: You can only use this offer if you have already completed the city registration within the TUM appointment described at the previous page. The Servicepoint can influence neither the processing time nor the decisions of the authorities.

You might have individual questions regarding your residence title during your studies. You are always welcome to contact our Service Point with these kind of questions. You can also contact the City of Heilbronn directly. Via <u>studentsHN@heilbronn.de</u> your request will be processed as quickly as possible by the respective authority. Please note that the TUM appointments can only be arranged with the Service Point and not via the above mentioned email address!
